Backstitches:

321 - christmas red	433 - brown - md	317 - pewter grey
815 - garnet - md	909 - emerald green - vy dk	676 - old gold - lt

Instructions:

The pattern is in the book, "Merry Christmas 1998," from Designs by Gloria & Pat, Inc. The pattern displays a kitten hanging from a wreath.

Special Instructions

***Option: When using red glass treasure bow (12056), use 2 strands of 321 floss to attach bow at top right of kittens head where there is two French knots marked in DMC floss color 321.

Add a little white stitch to the eyes with two strands where there are tiny ovals marked.

Eye – make a French knot in 3799 (1 strand, wrapped once).

Note: Wavy lines on chart indicate regular backstitch in a different color.

Backstitch in order given:

Backstitch inside of bells in 433.

Backstitch outside of bells in 5282 (676), using 1 strand.

Backstitch red ribbon (excluding wavy lines) and berries in 815.

Backstitch ribbon on mouse in 321.

Backstitch leaves and stems (excluding wavy lines) in 909.

Backstitch cat and mouse (including wavy lines) in 317.

Model

The design was stitched on a 14 ct. Antique White Aida, using 2 strands of floss for the full crosses and 1 strand for the backstitch.
